

Having qualified in 1976, Dr Chris Corbin served at home and abroad in the RAF Medical Branch as a station medical officer and as a radiologist until 1990. He then spent twelve years as an NHS GP in Berkhamsted, Hertfordshire, leaving to practise in the City of London and as Physician-in-Charge of the BUPA Wellness London Screening Centre.

Dr Corbin is registered with the General Medical Council, No. 2316279.

Available for consultation by appointment, Doctor Corbin will see you in his discreet and comfortable consulting room at his home, where he and his wife Marianne will welcome you. While earlier and later appointments may be arranged, no service can normally be provided out-of-hours. You are advised to remain registered with your NHS GP who, with your permission, will be kept fully informed.

General medical services are offered for the whole family, including the full range of diagnostic tests. Arrangements are made for referral for specialist advice as appropriate. Dr Corbin is experienced in childhood developmental assessment and well woman screening and offers personal and occupational health assessments and medical examinations of all types.

Dr Corbin is a CAA Approved Aviation Medical Examiner. Expert travel advice, immunisation and safety equipment are always available.

Consultations are normally half an hour but may be longer or shorter by arrangement and are charged pro rata, at the time of consultation, as follows:

- 15 minutes £75.00
- 30 minutes £150.00
- 45 minutes £225.00
- 60 minutes £300.00

A Registration Fee of £30.00 is charged to cover the cost of setting up the patient record and all documentation. In the case of a booking for a health assessment only, this is refundable against the relevant fee on attending.

Telephone and email consultations are charged at the same rates. Vaccines, medicines and dressings are priced as reasonably as possible. Laboratory tests and imaging investigations incur the providers' fees but these may be covered by your health insurance policy. No costs will be incurred without your informed consent. A full list of prices is available on request.

Normal surgery hours are between:

- 9am and 5pm on weekdays

Out-of-hours consultations incur a fee of one and a half times the standard rate.

A telephone answering machine is available to take non-urgent messages. No emergency service is available.

Personal information is held securely and managed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

Suggestions or comments about the practice are welcomed. If you are unhappy with the facilities or services you receive we would like to know about it as soon as possible so we can investigate your concerns and explain, apologise and take positive action where necessary. In most circumstances, if you tell us about your concern quickly, we can resolve matters straightaway.
